Weather Advisory for Delegates Attending STRI Week 2026 (Nairobi & Environs)

Delegates visiting Nairobi during 18–22 May 2026 should expect generally mild and improving weather conditions as the long-rain season tapers off. While isolated light showers may occur, the heavy rainfall experienced in early May is projected to reduce significantly by mid-May. Temperatures are expected to remain cool to moderate, particularly in the mornings and evenings.

20 May 2026 (Wed)	Mild conditions, slight chance of evening drizzle	15°C – 24°C	Suitable for outdoor engagements

22 May 2026 (Fri)	Mostly dry with sunny intervals	15°C – 25°C	Favorable for departures and excursions

Delegate Preparation Notes

- Nairobi mornings and evenings can be cool, especially for international delegates.
- A light waterproof jacket or umbrella is recommended.
- Daytime conditions are expected to be comfortable for conference sessions, networking events, and field visits.
- Traffic disruptions from weather are expected to be minimal compared to early May.
